

JUVENILE DETENTION BOARD MEETING
November 16, 2015 11:00 A.M.

Board members present: Sheriff Jonathan Held, Commissioner Anderson, Commissioner Kopas, and Controller Balzer.

Controller Jeff Balzer called the meeting to order.

A motion to approve the minutes of the August 11, 2015 meeting was made by Commissioner Anderson, seconded by Sheriff Held. Unanimous.

Director James W. Ringdal gave the Director's Report.

A total admission for March 31, 2015 to November 1, 2015 was 40 residents, 7 of those were out of county, and 1 was Act 96 youth. The Juvenile Detention has operated at 79% capacity from March 31, 2015 – August 1, 2015. The average daily population was 9.48 out of 12. There were 7 incident reports.

The juvenile facility was denied the waiver for 3800 regulations and will return the application for further consideration. The Director applied for the waiver to get additional bed authorization from the Department of Human Services the day after the last meeting. The Juvenile Center has been denied, however the Director will be returning the application for further consideration.

Four part time employees have been added to assist with overtime costs. .

Commissioner Anderson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Sheriff Held. Unanimous.
