

JUVENILE DETENTION BOARD MEETING  
March 28, 2016 10:30 A.M.

Board members present: Sheriff Jonathan Held, Commissioner Cerilli, Commissioner Anderson, Commissioner Kopas, and Controller Balzer.

Controller Jeff Balzer called the meeting to order.

A motion to approve the minutes of the November 16, 2015 meeting was made by Commissioner Kopas, seconded by Sheriff Held. Unanimous.

The Juvenile Detention Board met on February 29, 2015 to discuss a Personnel matter. The Juvenile Detention Board met on March 4, 2016 to discuss a Security matter.

Director James W. Ringdal gave the Director's Report.

A total admission for October 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015 was 42 residents, 6 of those were out of county. The Juvenile Detention has operated at 76% capacity from October 1, 2015 – December 31, 2015. The average daily population was 9.08 out of 12. There were 5 incident reports.

The PREA inspection has been scheduled for August 21-22, 2016.

The juvenile facility was denied the waiver for 3800 regulations and re-submitted the request on January 27, 2016. There has not been any reply so far.

Juvenile Detention has received notification from the Department of Human Services that the licensing inspection was successful.

Deputy Controller Garris reported that the process of adopting the role of an advisory judge as a voting member has been sent to local government committee and will then go before the House of Representatives.

Commissioner Anderson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Commissioner Kopas. Unanimous.
