Upcoming Trail Projects

Westmoreland Heritage Trail

The Westmoreland Heritage Trail is undergoing an expansion! Phase II of the Trail will be complete from Slickville towards Delmont. This 4-mile phase will add to the completed Phase I from Saltsburg to Slickville. A Grand Opening Ceremony is planned for the fall.

Little Crabtree Creek Trail

Eventually connecting Twin Lakes Park to Historic Hanna's Town following the Crabtree Creek Greenway, Phase I of the Little Crabtree Creek Trail will start in Twin Lakes and extend to Luxor for 1.3 miles. The LCCT will be a hiking, biking, walking, cross country skiing and equestrian trail using the abandoned railroad corridor. Construction is scheduled to begin this fall.
