# I WANT TO MARCH! How do I sign up & GET STARTED?

## Step 1. REGISTER

Registering online is the quickest way:

Then click the "Register Now" image or link and follow the steps to pre-register. You will see a confirmation page with more information about the March. **All Marchers and team members must register individually!**

## Step 2. COLLECT DONATIONS

Download a Contribution Form to list monetary commitments from your supporters. All money donated will go to Westmoreland County park and trail projects of your choice, or wherever most needed.

Individually collect \$25 and get an official March for Parks T-shirt or doggie bandana. Collect \$150 or more and get a gift card (see back of brochure).

*Gift Cards and T-Shirts are based on INDIVIDUAL contributions. If you have raised team money and wish to have it credited accordingly, please fill out a registration form for each team member!*

## Step 3. COME TO THE MARCH!

The event is held rain or shine! Bring your Contribution Form (if completed) and all donations collected. ALL MARCHERS must report to the check-in station the day of the March.

Registration begins at 8:30 a.m. and the Marches start at 10:30 a.m.

# WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

Recent and current projects for which March for Parks funds have been designated:

- Cedar Creek Park Master Planning and Dog Park
- Acquisition and engineering of the Turtle Creek Extension of the Westmoreland Heritage Trail
- Deck Hockey Rink, Amphitheater, Dog Park, Winter Sports Area, Accessible Playground, Peach Plaza Skate and Action Park and other facilities at the Twin Lakes Park Expansion.
- Little Crabtree Creek, Westmoreland Heritage, and Coal & Coke Trails

This year you will have the opportunity to designate the funds you raise to go to various Parks and Trails.

### Choices include:

- **Cedar Creek Park Projects, including an off-leash dog park and R.C. airfield improvements**
- **Construction of the Turtle Creek Extension of the Westmoreland Heritage Trail**
- **Mammoth Park projects, including Giant Slide upgrade and Disc Golf course**
- **Land Acquisition**
- **Wherever most needed**

# MARCH FOR PARKS...TIMES 3!

Like last year, we will host the March for Parks in three locations in 2017: **Cedar Creek Park** in Rostraver Township, **Twin Lakes Park** near Greensburg, and the **Murrysville SportZone**, in support of the Turtle Creek Extension of the Westmoreland Heritage Trail



At Cedar Creek we are master planning a section of the park with plans to include a dog park, boundless playground, upgraded restrooms with flush toilets, accessible walkways and other items. We are also planning improvements and upgrades to the R.C. Model Airfield.

In Murrysville we are concentrating on the Turtle Creek Extension of the Westmoreland Heritage Trail and are preparing for construction of 5.9 miles of trail in 2017. There are bridge renovations to fund as well as additional engineering to extend the trail from Murrysville into Export.

At Mammoth Park, we are preparing for upgrades to the Giant Slide, a Disc Golf course, and renovations to the Tennis Courts and Dek Hockey Courts.

At Northmoreland Park, we are making improvements to the BMX track as well as improving various athletic fields.

We are always working to replace and improve our play and picnic areas, restroom facilities, parking, roads, and other support facilities in all our parks.
