

On April 6, 2005, Scotty lost the use of both eyes when a suicide car bomber blew himself up in front of Scotty's Stryker vehicle in Iraq.

His future dreams were taken from him. With his wife Tiffany's love and the support of others, Scotty was transformed. He has climbed Mt. Rainier, surfed, skydived, became a father, earned an MBA from Duke, taught leadership at West Point and commanded an army company.
