The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources’ Bureau of Recreation and Conservation 2022 grant program for public recreation and conservation projects opens Jan. 18, 2022 and closes on April 6th, 2022 at 4:00pm.

The workshop will provide information to potential applicants on DCNR grants available for public recreation and conservation projects. Grants are funded through a variety of funding sources including the Keystone Recreation and Conservation Fund, Environmental Stewardship Fund, Pennsylvania Recreational Trails Program, and the Land and Water Conservation Fund. Participants in this grant workshop will be provided with in-depth information on projects eligible for DCNR’s grant funds, how to develop a competitive “ready-to-go” application, eligible applicants, and matching fund requirements. Participants will also receive guidance and updates on the application process and the documents required for each type of project, and have the opportunity to interact with Bureau of Recreation and Conservation staff. Community leaders, municipal officials, consultants, land trusts, board members, trail managers, and park and recreation professionals are encouraged to attend.

DIRECTIONS TO TWIN LAKES PARK:

From the West:

Take Rt. 30 towards Greensburg. Turn onto Donohoe Rd at the traffic light in front of Westmoreland Mall. Follow the road to the right towards the Toys R Us store. Continue straight through a traffic light and two stops signs. Turn left after the second stop sign and follow the signs to Twin Lakes Park main entrance. Once entered, the Activity Center is on the far left.

From the East:

Take Route 30 towards Greensburg. Turn right onto Georges Station Road at the traffic Light by Red Lobster. Continue to the next stop sign and make a right onto Donohoe Road. After the next stop sign turn left onto Twin Lakes Road and follow the signs to Twin Lakes Park main entrance. Once entered, the Activity Center is on the far left.
