



## Westmoreland Manor Visitation Guidelines

- All visitors must enter through the front entrance and successfully complete the screening questions and temperature check after sanitizing hands. You must wash your hands or use ABHR frequently (preferred) throughout your time in the building including when you leave. Visitors will be restricted from visitation regardless of vaccination status for those with a positive viral test for COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19 or currently meet the criteria for quarantine.
- Visitors will adhere to the core principles of Infection Control per QSO-20-39-NH. Including well-fitting face masks (covering mouth and nose), physical distancing of 6 feet, and frequent hand hygiene.
- Instructional signage is placed throughout the facility to provide education on COVID -19 signs and symptoms, infection prevention measures and applicable facility procedures.
- Visitors are able to transport their loved one to a visiting area but leg rests must be in place if resident is not self-propelling.
- If a resident's roommate is unvaccinated or immunocomprised (regardless of vaccination status), visits should not be conducted in the residents room, if possible
- Cleaning and disinfection of highly touched surfaces in the facility and designated visitation areas after each visit will be performed. Please limit touching surfaces while in the facility.
- If a visitor becomes ill during the visit, they are to report their symptoms and leave the facility immediately.
- At this time, no meals will be available for purchase for visitors. Visitors and residents should not eat together.
- New admissions that are not fully vaccinated (or cannot show proof of full vaccination) will need to complete a 14-day quarantine period. Residents may have visitors during this time however know that there is a potential risk to the visitor. Visitors should adhere to the core principles of infection prevention.
- Visitors who are unable to adhere to the core principals of infection control will not be permitted to visit or will be asked to leave. This includes wearing a mask at all times and physically distancing as the County is in area of high transmission.
